# GREATNESS OF SAYYIDUNA

### Excellence of Siddique al-Akbar, mentioned by Ali Al-Murtada 446

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The love between the first caliph, Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddique رَمِنَ اللَّهُ مَـنَّة and the fourth caliph, Sayyiduna Ali al-Murtada رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ was unique. These two individuals had established a deep relationship of love and brotherhood, the extent of which can be seen through the sayings of Sayyiduna Ali al-Murtada دَمِنِي اللَّهُ عَنْهُ, for on several occasions, he expressed the rank of Savyiduna stated رَفِيَ اللَّهُ عَنَّهُ Sayyiduna Ali رَفِيَ اللَّهُ عَنَّهُ stated regarding the bravery of Savviduna Abu Bakr Siddigue On the day of Badr, we built a canopy for the :رَفِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ protection and service of the Prophet مَسَلُى اللُّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَإِلَهِ وَسَلُّم protection and service of the Prophet . None of us advanced forward except Abu Bakr مَلْ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَأَلِهِ who stood by the Prophet رَفِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ عَالَهُ with a naked sword. No disbeliever came close to the وَسَلَم Prophet مَلْ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَإِلَى وَمَنْم and this is why, from amongst us, the bravest is Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddique رَفِيَ اللَّهُ عَنَّهُ عَنَّهُ.

On one occasion, he stated regarding the passion of faith of Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddique (زون الله عنه 'I swear by Allah, one moment from the blessed life of Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddique زون الله عنه is better than thousands of moments from the life of the believer from the family of Fir'awn. That person (the believer from the family of Fir'awn) would hide his faith and this pure being would publicly announce his faith.<sup>2</sup>

Maula Ali تَرَيِّهُ الْحَرِيْمُ اللَّهُ وَجَهَةُ الْحَرِيْمِ اللَّهُ وَجَهَةُ الْحَرِيْمِ Bakr Siddique تَرَخِيَ اللَّهُ عَنَّهُ وَحَلَّمُ superior in matters of the religion and the world, and he states: 'The Beloved Prophet مَتَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالَّهِ وَسَلَّمُ ordered Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddique عَلَيْهِ وَالَّهُ وَحَلَّمُ to lead the people in prayer. I was present at the time and I did not have any illness. Sayyiduna Muhammad bin Hanafiya دَفِيَ اللَّهُ عَنَّهُ states that

زَعَنَ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَلَيهِ وَسَلَّهُ Ali al-Murtada (عَنَّهُ): 'Who is the most superior from amongst the people after the Noble Prophet ? مَتَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَلَيهِ وَسَلَّم He replied: Abu Bakr ?. وَعَنَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَلَيهِ وَسَلَّم

It is evident that you will only praise someone if you have love for them in your heart, and these pure individuals are protected from lying. Thus, we can never contemplate that they can gave false praises. Therefore, in light of all of these sayings of Sayyiduna Ali al-Murtada (زون الله عنه الله عنه), it is clear that Sayyiduna Ali al-Murtada (زون الله عنه), it is clear that Sayyiduna Ali al-Akbar (زون الله عنه), which spurred him to extol the virtues of Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddique

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# Sayyiduna Abu Bakr al-Siddiq A Mirror of the Prophet

The greatest goal and desire of every true Muslim, and especially the Sahabah رَفِيَ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ , is to follow their Beloved Prophet مَلْ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم and in every action of their hearts and limbs. The more successful a person is in attaining this goal, the more he resembles the Beloved of Allah aperson of their hearts and thereby, the more successful he is in gaining proximity to Allah Almighty. The pleasure of Allah Almighty first directs itself towards the Beloved Prophet مَلْ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم prophet مَلْ اللهُ عَلَى اللهُ عَلَى وَسَلَّم means, it is attained by those who follow him, rank by rank.

#### The basis of salvation in the Hereafter

Guaranteed salvation in the Hereafter and loftiness of ranks in Paradise are dependent upon resemblance with the Beloved Prophet مَصَ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَلِهِ وَسَاً. The more dissimilar a person's actions and words are from his, the more distant he is from Allah Almighty, and the more he resembles him, the closer he is to Allah Almighty. The disbelievers have made their words and actions completely different to that of the Beloved Prophet, الله عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَمَالَى مَالَ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَمَالَى consequently, they are worthy of Hell for eternity. Whereas, the Sahabah مَوَى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَمَالَى chose complete resemblance, thereby, becoming the most superior from the Ummah.

This entire discussion relates to those words and actions, in terms of resembling or not resembling a person, which an individual has control over. The one



whom Allah Almighty favours with His boundless grace and generosity, He causes them to resemble His Beloved مَسَلُ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَلِهِ وَسَلَّمُ in those matters who are beyond their control too, and He attaches their liking, disliking, thinking, imagination, nature and disposition so closely to the Beloved Prophet مَسَلُ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَلِهِ وَسَلَّم that they become a reflection of this couplet:

Fana itna tau ho jaoon mayn tayri Zaat-e-'Aali Mayn

Jo mujh ko daykh Le us ko tayra deedar ho jaye

From the Ummah, the Noble Sahabah رَضِىَ اللَّهُ عَنْيَهُ وَلَهِ وَسَمَّ لَعَلَيْهُ وَلَهِ وَسَمَّ resemble the Beloved Prophet مَسَلُ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَلِهِ وَسَمَّ most, from the Sahabah, the Four Rightly-guided Caliphs have the greatest honour in this regard, and from the four Noble Caliphs, Sayyiduna Abu Bakr al-Siddiq four Noble Caliphs, Sayyiduna Abu Bakr al-Siddiq intensity of his similarities. The personal blessed characteristics of the Beloved Prophet مَسَلُ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّهُ that were granted to him (Sayyiduna Abu Bakr is the fore from the second to anyone else. From these many resemblances, only 4 are being mentioned here:

#### (1) Similarity in thinking and reasoning

Allah Almighty had made the thinking of Sayyiduna Abu Bakr al-Siddiq تَوَقَى اللَّهُ عَنَّ similar to that of the Beloved Prophet's. If two mirrors were placed in front of each other, then the thing that can be seen in one will be seen in the other. This becomes absolutely clear after reading about the consultations of the Beloved Prophet مَنْ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَلِيهِ وَسَلَّمُ with the Sahabah رَضِ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهُ مَنْ on various occasions and about other accounts in detail. Read one example here: The conditions that were stipulated on the occasion

of the Treaty of Hudaybiyah apparently gave the impression that the Muslims were weak. Sayyiduna Umar al-Farooq توني الله عنه disliked this greatly, so he روني الله عنه presented himself in the Prophetic court and mentioned his grievance. Upon this, the Beloved of Allah من الله عليه واله وتدام mentioned some words in order to bring comfort to his heart, and gave answers to some of his questions.

After leaving from there, Sayyiduna Umar al-Farooq ثرين الله عليه نه نه went to Sayyiduna Abu Bakr al-Siddique ريين الله عليه الله عليه بنه منه thinking that perhaps the opinion of the Sayyiduna Abu Bakr al-Siddiq ترين الله عليه نه would be the same as his, and he would mention this in the Prophetic court. #### (2) Hatred for idols and idol-worship

Hatred for false gods and their worship is something that Allah Almighty placed in the nature of every Prophet. Some prophets did not respect idols even in their childhood, whereas, the excellence of the Leader of all Prophets مَدَلُ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم prostrated to Allah Almighty as soon as he was born, and proclaimed Tawhid (Oneness of Allah) openly.

Sayyiduna Abu Bakr al-Siddiq ترفي الله عنه also displayed this attribute, and never prostrated to an idol. At a very young age, his father took him to a temple and said, 'These are your elevated gods, so prostrate to them.' Saying this, he walked away. He زوی الله عنه went in front of the idol and said, 'I am hungry, so feed me, I am naked, so clothe me, I am going to hit you with a stone, so save yourself if you are God.' What reply could the idol give? He زوی الله عنه hit it with a stone and it fell upon its face.<sup>2</sup>

#### (3) Mercy for the Ummah

The Messenger of Allah صَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِّهِ وَسَلَّمُ is compassionate and merciful towards all of creation



in general, and specifically towards his Ummah. Allah Almighty states:

#### وَمَا اَرْسَلُنْكَ إِلَّا رَحْمَةً لِّلْعُلَمِيْنَ ٥٠٥

And We did not send you (O Beloved) but as a mercy for all the worlds.

[Kanz-ul-Iman (translation of Quran)] (Part 17, Surah Al-Ambiya, Verse 107)

In another place, He says:

From the Ummah, Sayyiduna Abu Bakr al-Siddiq رَضِ اللهُ عَنَهُ is the most compassionate and merciful towards the Ummah of his Master صَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيُهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّمُ The Beloved Prophet صَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّمُ

اَرْحَمُ أُمَّتِي بِإُمَّتِي آبُو بَكْرِ meaning, 'The most merciful of my Ummah towards my Ummah is Abu Bakr.'³

### (4) Gathering point of virtues and perfections:

Allah Almighty gathered all virtues and perfections in the blessed being of His Beloved مَسَلُ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم There is not a virtue and excellence that was granted to the previous prophets except that a similar virtue was granted to our Beloved Prophet مَتَلُ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَلَكِهِ وَسَلَّم or to an even greater degree.

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# Eminence of Siddeeq-e-Akbar mentioned by the Holy Prophet

O devotees of the Prophet! Out of all the creations of Allah Almighty, after the Prophets and Messengers, Sayyiduna Siddeeq-e-Akbar رَفِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ is the greatest. Many virtues regarding him have been mentioned in the Holy Quran and the blessed Ahadees. 22<sup>nd</sup> Jumadal Ukhra is the day of his passing.

- From my Ummah, the most merciful to the Ummah is Abu Bakr Siddeeq (نَفِيَ اللهُ عَنهُ). (*Ibn-e-Majah, vol. 1, p. 102, Hadees 154*)
- Allah Almighty dislikes the fact that Abu Bakr Siddeeq (مون الله عنه) commits a mistake on the earth. (Kanz-ul-'Ummal, vol. 6, p. 250, Hadees 32570, juzz 11)
- Jibra`eel مَلَيْهِ السَّلَامِ came to me and said: 'Allah Almighty commands you to consult with Abu Bakr Siddeeq دَيْضَ اللهُ عَنَّهُ (Jami'-ul-Ahadees, vol. 1, p. 78, Hadees 374)
- 4. Every Prophet has two ministers among the dwellers of the sky and two ministers among the dwellers of the earth. My ministers in the sky are Jibra`eel and Mika`eel (مَالَيُها السُلَام), whereas on the earth are Abu Bakr and 'Umar (مَالَيُها السُلَام). (Tirmizi, vol. 5, p. 382, Hadees 3700)
- 5. Apart from the Prophets and Messengers, Abu Bakr and 'Umar (رَضِنَ اللهُ عَنهُما) are the leaders of all the former and latter middle age dwellers of paradise. O 'Ali, رَضِنَ اللهُ عَنهُ do not tell them of this.<sup>1</sup> (*Tirmizi, vol. 5, p. 376, Hadees 3686*)

(Hadaiq-e-Bakhshish, p. 130)

- 6. The dwellers of the higher levels of Paradise will look upon the dwellers of the lower level of Paradise just like you see the stars rise on the edge of the sky. Undoubtedly, 'Umar and Abu Bakr (نوی الله عنه) are also among those people (of the higher level). (*Tirmizi, vol. 5, p. 372, Hadees 3678*)
- After me, follow Abu Bakr and 'Umar (نَفِنَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُما). (Tirmizi, vol. 5, p. 374, Hadees 3682)
- Both of them (i.e., Abu Bakr and 'Umar (نَفِنَ اللهُ عَنْهُمَا), in terms of importance) are like the ears and eyes. (*Tirmizi, vol. 5, p. 378, Hadees 3691*)
- 9. On the Day of Judgement, a proclaimer will call out: 'No one from this Ummah pick up

their book of deeds before Abu Bakr and 'Umar نَوْضَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُمَا.' (Jam'-ul-Jawami', vol. 1, p. 244, Hadees 1757)

- I will be the first to come out of my grave, after me will be Abu Bakr and then 'Umar (نَفِنَ اللَّهُ عَنَهُما). (Tirmizi, vol. 5, p. 388, Hadees 3712)
- 11. A woman came to the court of the Holy Prophet مَلْ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَم and expressed her matter, to which she was commanded to come again. Referring to the apparent passing, she said: 'What if I come and do not find you?' He مَلْ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ مَعَالَى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ مَعَالَى said: 'If you do not see me, then go to Abu Bakr.' [Kanz-ul-Iman (translation of Quran)](Part 17, Surah Al-Ambiya, Ayah 90) O pious bondmen of Allah Almighty! Be aware, undoubtedly, Allah Almighty has held in pledge your souls for His right and He موقعة has taken a (firm) covenant from you upon it and has bought this little and mortal life from you at the cost of an endless life. You have the Divine Book of Allah Almighty whose wonders do not cease nor does its Noor [spiritual light] fade. Testify the blessed verses of glorious Quran and seek advice from it; moreover, seek spiritual light from it for the dark day (i.e. Day of

Judgement). Undoubtedly, Allah Almighty has created you to worship [Him] and has appointed over you, كِرَامًاكَاتِبِيْــن The angels that record a person's deeds) and they know what you do.

> O bondmen of Allah Almighty! Be aware! You are spending your time from morning to evening till an appointed time (i.e. till death) and you have not been given any knowledge about it [death]. If you can devote your time to spending in the deeds that please Allah Almighty,

then you must do so but it is not possible without the Taufeeq of Allah Almighty. So, take advantage of the remaining time period of your life and excel each other in (good) deeds before death approaches you and turn you back to your bad acts as many nations spent their lives for others ignoring themselves. It is for the reason I forbid you, to be like them. Hasten to attain salvation! Undoubtedly death is chasing you and it will approach very soon. (Musannaf Ibn-e-Abi Shaybah, vol. 8, pp. 144, Hadees 1)

May Allah Almighty also grant us Taufeeq to prepare for the Hereafter while acting upon these pieces of advice.

# The incomparable virtues of Sayyiduna Siddeeq-e-Akbar رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ

Let's go through a few such virtues and excellence of Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddeeq کنه الله عنه in which he is matchless and incomparable:

### 1-2. Sani Isnain [the second of the two]

For Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddeeq رَمِنَ اللهُ عَنْهُ عَلَهُ عَلَهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهُ عَنْهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهُ عَنْهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهُ عَنْهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّمُ i.e. 'The companion of the Beloved Rasool (صاحب) (تانى النين) and 'مَعْلُى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم (ثانى الني النين) (The second of the two) in the Holy Quran. (Part 10, Surah Al-Taubah, Ayah 40)

Nobody else was blessed with this honour.

#### 3. The name, 'Siddeeq'

Allah Almighty gave him the name Siddeeq. Nobody else was given the name Siddique by Allah Almighty.

The fortunate people who had the blessed company of the Beloved Rasool صَلْى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَإِلَيهِ وَسَلَّمُ with faith even for a single moment and their life ended with faith, are called Sahabah [blessed Companions] . رَضِيَ السلُّهُ عَنْهُم [blessed Companions] were pious, just دَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُم were pious, just and abstinent. They were ready to sacrifice their lives for the Beloved Rasool متلى الله عَلَيْهِ وَالله وَسَلَم and possess countless virtues and excellences along with receiving the glad tidings of Allah Almighty being pleased with them. But in the long list of these blessed personalities, there were a number of those blessed companions رَضِى اللَّهُ عَنْهُم who possessed such virtues and excellence which were not shared with anybody else. The name of the personality who topped this list was the one about whom, when Sayyiduna Muhammad Bin Hanfiyah رَحْمَةُ اللهِ عَلَيْه asked his blessed father, Sayyiduna Ali-ul-Murtada ذيف الله عنه: 'Who is the best person amongst the Ummah after the Beloved Rasool ?? مَسَلُ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَإِلَهِ وَسَلَم Sayyiduna Ali-ul-Murtada رَمِنَ اللهُ عَنْهُ stated: 'Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddeeq دَفِعَ اللهُ مَسَنَّة (Bukhari, vol. 2, pp. 522, Hadees 3671)

#### 4. Companion during Hijrah [migration]

Due to the cruelties, oppression and tyrannies inflicted by the disbelievers of Makkah; the Beloved Rasool مَسْ اللَّهُ عَلَيَّهِ وَالِّهِ وَسَلَّمَ migrated from the blessed Makkah, and in this migration, Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddeeq تَوْمَنَ اللَّهُ عَلَيَّهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّمَ

#### 5. Companion in the cave

In this very migration, verily he نَعْنَ اللَّهُ عَنَهُ was the only one to have the privilege of becoming the companion in the cave. (*Faizan-e-Siddeeq-e-Akbar, pp. 493*)

## 6. Only the door of Abu Bakr will remain open

تَسَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم The Munificent and Beneficent Rasool مَسْلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم instructed during his final days: All doors in the Masjid (Nabavi) should be shut except the door of



Abu Bakr. (Bukhari, vol. 1, pp. 177, Hadees 664 – Tafheem-ul-Bukhari, vol. 1, pp. 818)

#### 7) The very first to enter Paradise

The Beloved Rasool متل الله عَتِيهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم has stated: Jibraeel Ameen مَتَلَقِفُ الله عَتَقِهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم showed me that door through which my Ummah will enter Paradise. Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddeeq وَعَنَ اللهُ عَتَهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم humbly requested: 'Ya Rasoolallah اللهُ عَنه It is my wish that I were with you at that time so that I would have also seen that door.' The Rasool of Rahmah, the Intercessor of Ummah, the Distributor of Ni'mah, the Owner of Jannah, the Distributor of Ni'mah, the Owner of Jannah مَتَد وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم stated: 'Abu Bakr! You will be the first person from my Ummah to enter Paradise.' (*Abu Dawood, vol. 4, pp. 280, Hadees 4652*)

#### 8) Three morsels and three congratulations

Once the Beloved Rasool صَلْ الله عَلَيْهِ وَإِلَهِ وَسَلَم prepared food صَلَى اللهُ he رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُم and called the blessed Companions , رَضِيَ اللهُ gave one morsel each to all the blessed عَلَيْهِ وَأَلِهِ وَسَلُّم gave صَلَى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَم whereas, he رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُم gave زين الله three morsels to Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddeeq asked the reason behind رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ Sayyiduna Abbas مَا عَنْهُ it. He مَسْ الله عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَسْمَ replied: When I gave the first morsel, Sayyiduna Jibraeel عَلَيْهِ السَّلَام said: O 'Ateeq! Congratulations to you. When I gave the second !said: O Rafeeq عَلَيْتِ السُّلَام said: O Rafeeq Congratulations to you. When I gave the third Allah Almighty said: O Siddeeq! morsel, Congratulations to you. (Al-Haawi Lil-Fatawa, vol. 2, pp. 51)

#### 9) Superior to all

Sayyiduna Abu Darda وَعِنَ اللَّهُ عَنَهُ has stated: The Rasool of Rahmah, the Intercessor of Ummah, the Distributor of Ni'mah, the Owner of Jannah عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّم عَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَعَلَّم saw me walking ahead of Abu Bakr Siddeeq وَلَهِ وَعَلَّم and said: 'Are you walking ahead of him who is superior to you? Don't you know that after the Prophets and Rusul, the sun neither rose nor set on anybody better than Abu Bakr.' (*Fazail-ul-Khulafa La-Abi Naeem, pp. 38, Hadees 10*)

#### 10. Masjid in the courtyard of the house

Before migration, Abu Bakr Siddeeq لرض الله قلية built a Masjid in the courtyard of his house. Sayyidatuna Aisha Siddiqah توسع الله قلية has stated: 'Since I reached the age of discernment, my parents were following Islam. No day passed without the Beloved Rasool أنه قليه قليه واله قلية مثل visiting our home in the two corners, in the morning and in the evening. Then Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddeeq أنه قلله قلية قليه واله قلية courtyard of his home. Then he أنه ماله الله قلية الله قلية Salah in it and recite the Holy Quran (aloud). The sons and women of disbelievers used to listen to it and get surprised and would look at him. (Bukhari, vol. 1, pp. 180, Hadees 476, Tafheem-ul-Bukhari, vol. 1, pp. 829)

#### 11. The most beneficial amongst all

The Beloved Rasool مسل الله عليه والله وتسلم once stated: 'The one whose companionship and wealth have benefitted me the most amongst all people is Abu Bakr (ترفين الله قسنة); and if I were to make a Khalil (best friend) from my Ummah, I would have chosen Abu Bakr (ترفين الله قسنة) but the brotherhood of Islam is sufficient.' (Bukhari, vol. 2, pp. 591, Hadees 3904)

#### 12. Companionship at the Pond of Kausar

The Beloved Rasool مَسَلَّ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِّهِ وَسَنَّةً once said to Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddeeq تَرَفِقَ اللَّهُ عَنَةً You are my companion at the Pond of Kausar and you are my companion of the cave. (*Tirmizi, vol. 5, pp. 378, Hadees* 3690)

#### 13. The kindest person

The Rasool of Rahmah, the Intercessor of Ummah, ن من الله Distributor of Ni'mah, the Owner of Jannah من الله عنه واله وَسَلَّم will migrate with me?' Sayyiduna Jibraeel Amin عنه humbly replied: 'Abu Bakr (توع الله قـــة). He will manage the matters of your Ummah after you and he (توع الله قـــة) is the most superior in the Ummah and the kindest person towards the Ummah.' (Jami'-ul-Jawami' vol. 11, pp. 39, Hadees 160)



#### 14. The favours of Sayyiduna Abu Bakr Siddeeq زَفِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ

The Rasool of mankind, the Peace of our heart and mind, the Most Generous and Kind سَلْى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلْم stated: There is no favour due upon me from anyone, except that I have repaid him, but verily Abu Bakr (نَوْهِ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ) has those favours upon me which Allah (عَرْهَ جَلْ) will repay him for on Judgement Day. (*Tirmizi,* vol. 5, pp. 374, Hadees 3681)

#### 15) Special Divine Manifestation

#### The first man to embrace Islam

(i.e. Allah من الله ترب وتله and His Prophet Beloved Prophet الله تكن الله تجب وتب وتله and His Beloved Prophet Subul Al-Huda Wa-Al-Rashad Fi Sirat Khayr Al-Thad, vol. 5, p. 435)
