

Good conduct with the mother-in-law






Wisdom of the name Ramadan



Formula for attaining pleasure in worship




Worldly speech in the masjid




Virtue of seeking knowledge in old age






Virtue of the 'imāmah




Dirty petrol


In the Madani Muzakarah of 24th of Ramadan al-Mubārak, the following narration was also mentioned:


Means for earning will be found




Portion of the Night of Power






Eid Mubārak
