A further addition to the QR codes in this *Part 3* are those codes for Amir Ahl al-Sunnah's daily sessions for the Prophetic devotees performing *i'tikāf*, covering rulings from *Laws of Salah*, etc. These sessions would take place after Haji Imran Attari's post-Fajr speeches in the International Madani Markaz, Faizan-e-Madinah, Karachi. 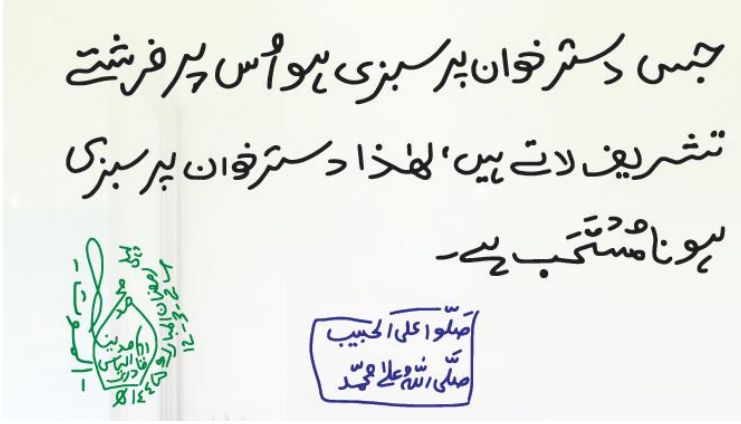

Therefore, it is recommended to have vegetables on the dining mat.<sup>1</sup>



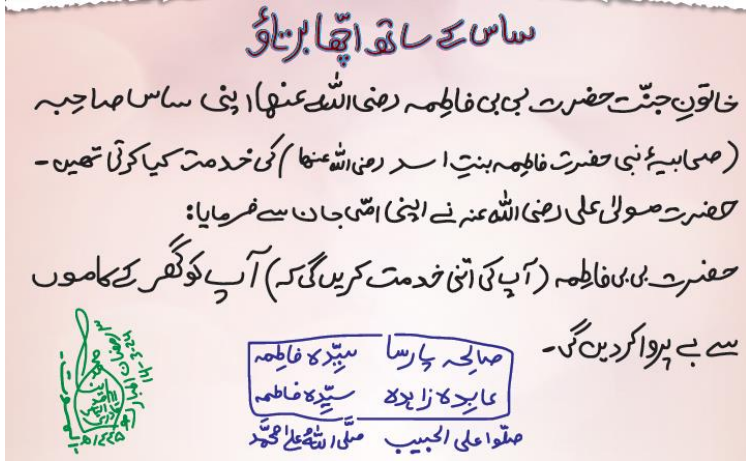

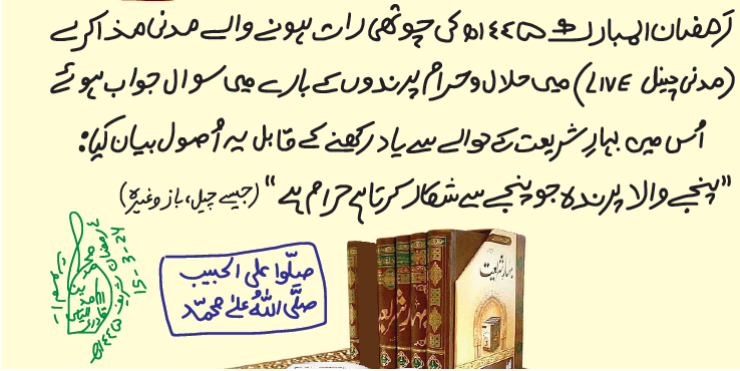
### Good conduct with the mother-in-law

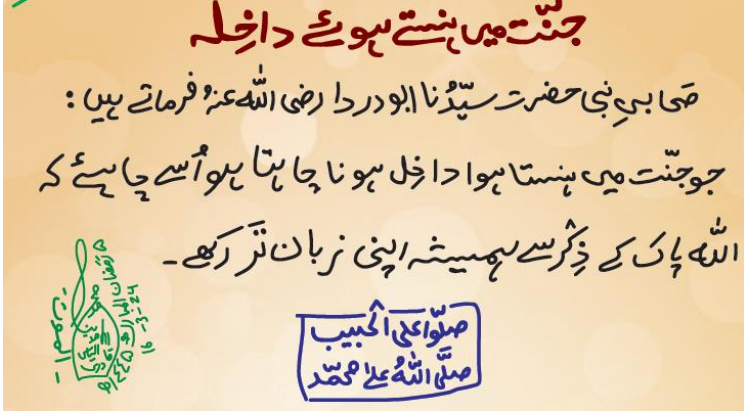

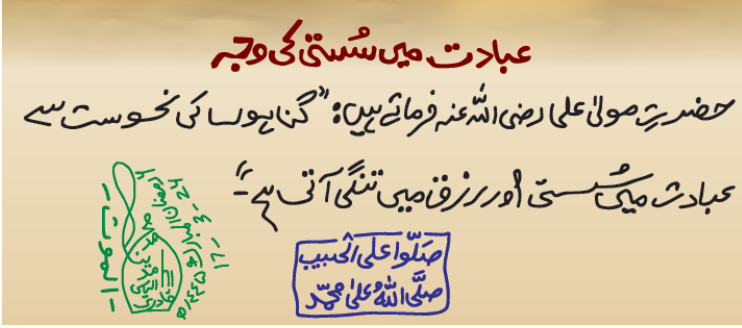


### Entry into Jannah laughing

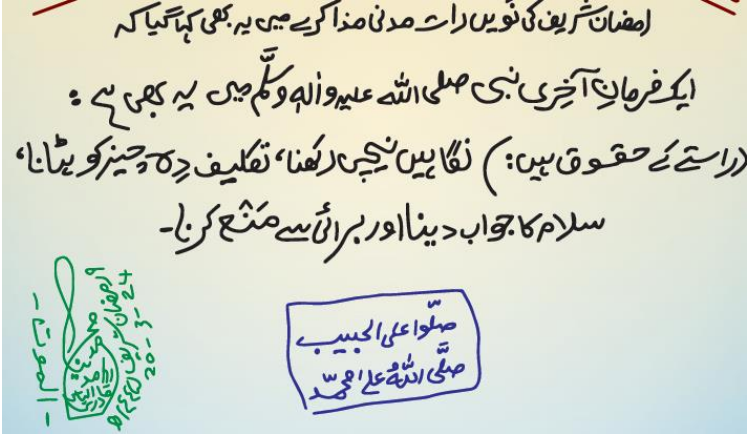


### Sign of the displeasure of Allah Almighty

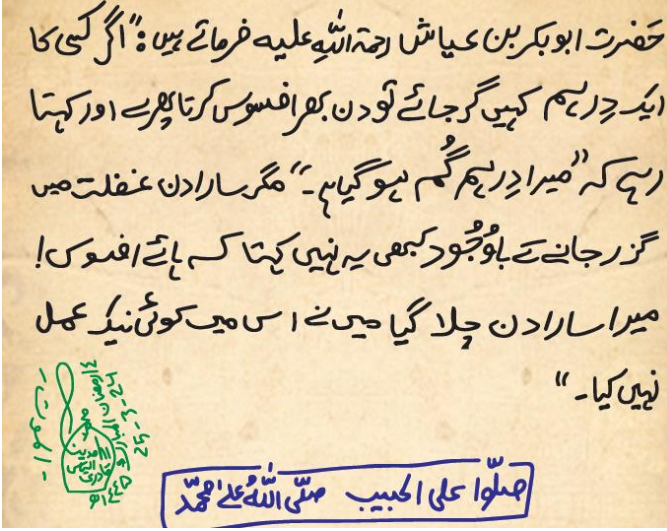


### Wisdom of the name Ramadan

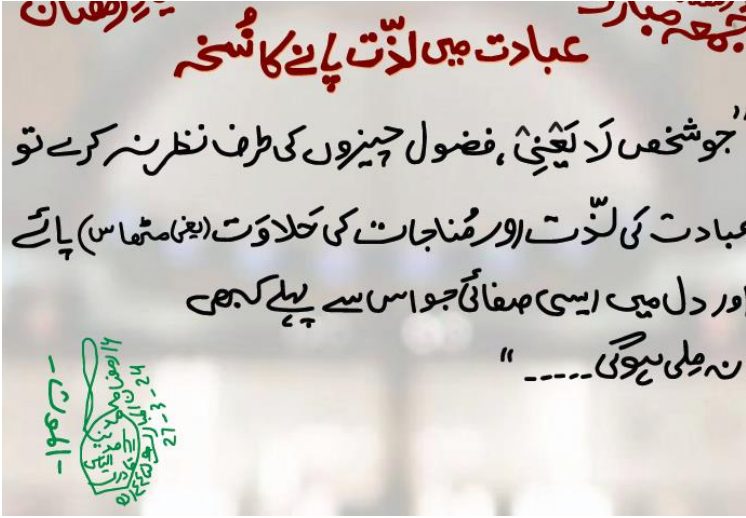
### 70 draughts from the water of al-Kawthar

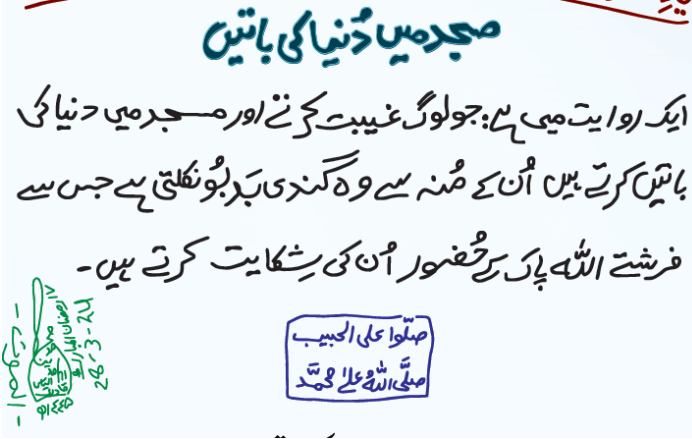


### Formula for attaining pleasure in worship

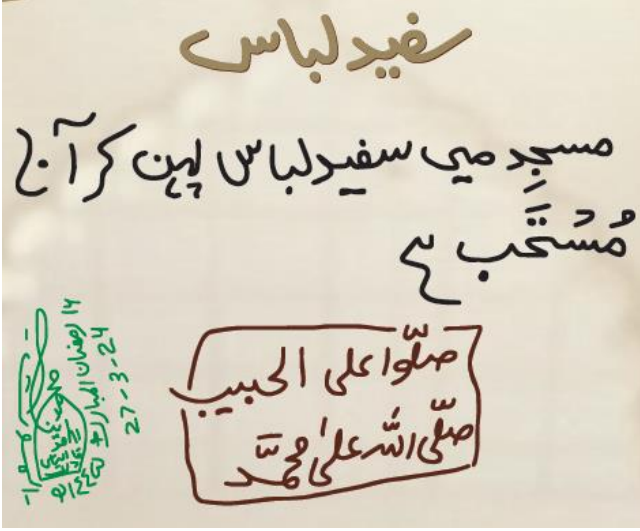
### Worldly speech in the masjid

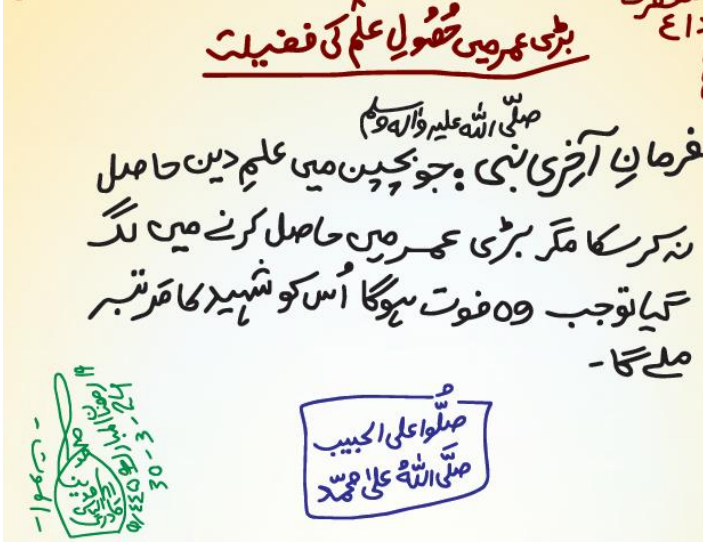
### White clothing

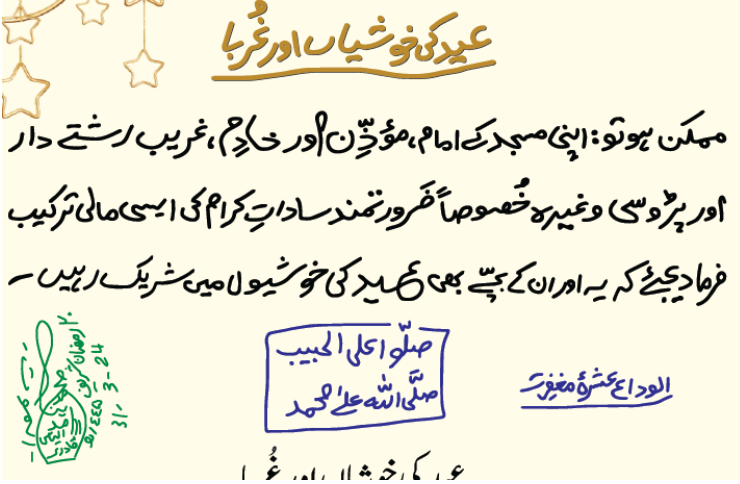


### Virtue of seeking knowledge in old age

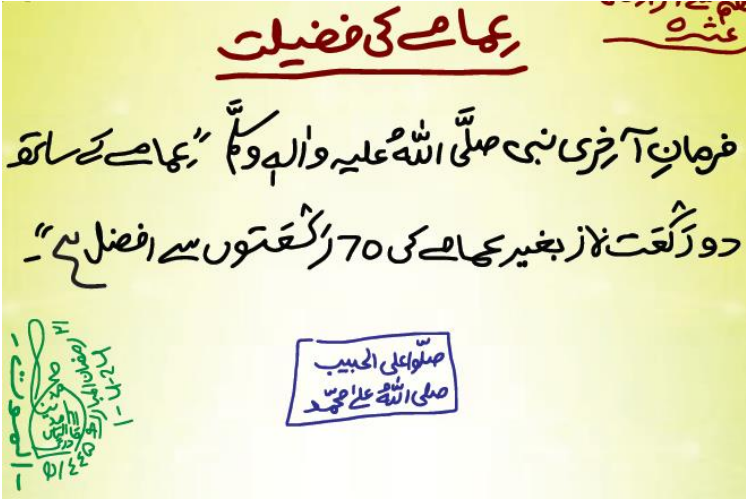

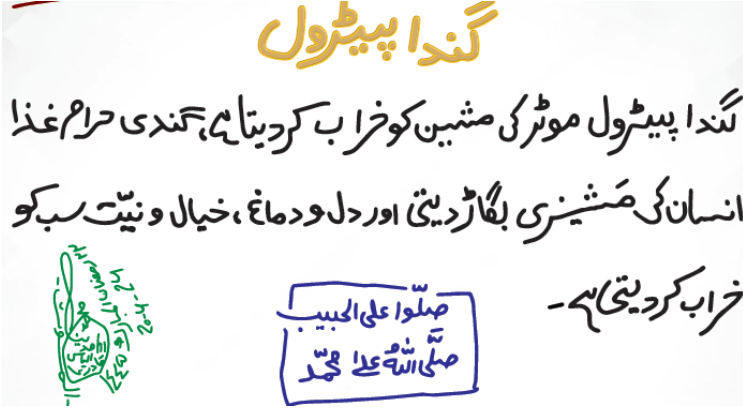


### Virtue of the 'imāmah

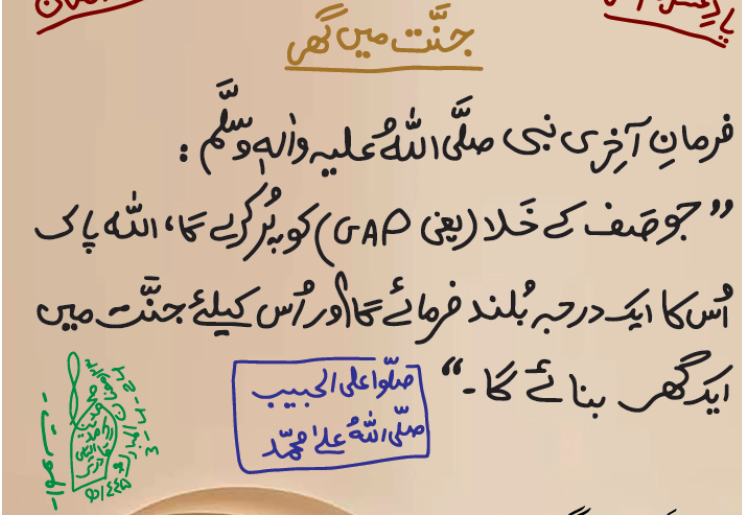


### Dirty petrol

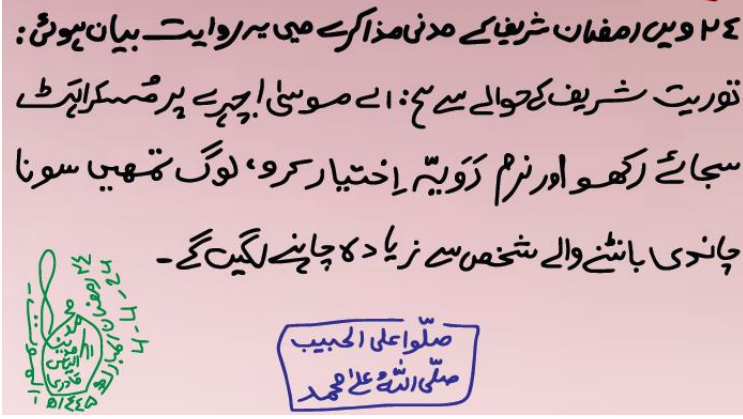
### House in Paradise

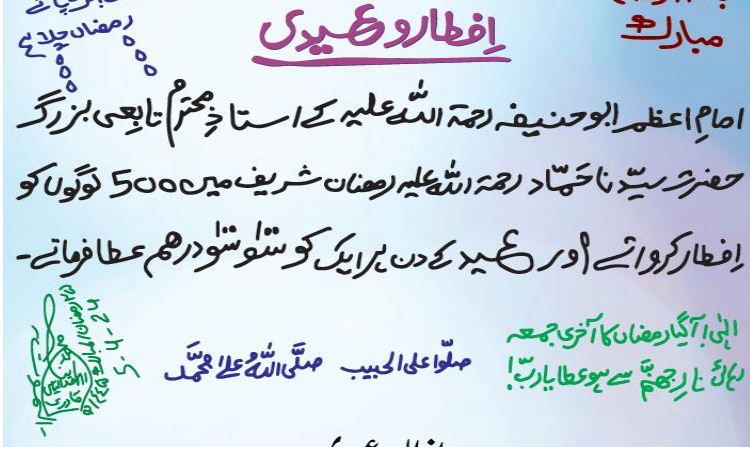


In the Madani Muzakarah of 24<sup>th</sup> of Ramadan al-Mubārak, the following narration was also mentioned:

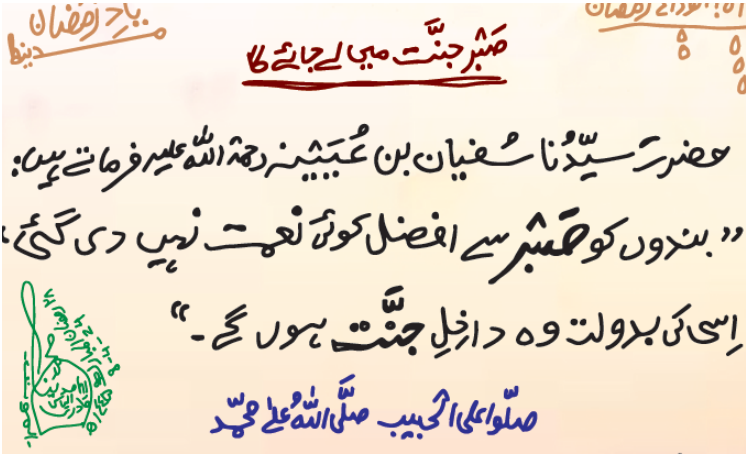


### Portion of the Night of Power

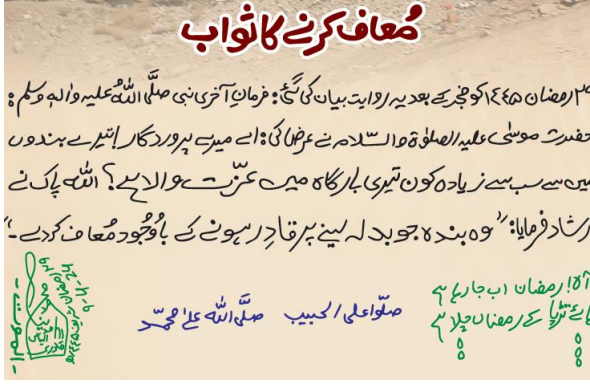


### Patience will lead to Paradise

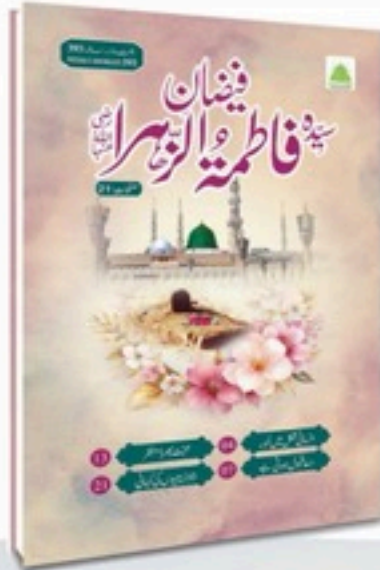


## Eid Mubarak
