Last 10-day Sunnah I'tikaf Schedule

Madinah: The schedule may be amended after consultation with the relevant member of Shura or Nigran of Kabinat or Nigran of Kabinah.

Dear Islamic brothers! Let's make as many of the following good intentions as are possible for us. We should develop the habit of saying **إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ**, whilst keeping its meaning in mind. '**إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ**' means, 'If Allah **عَزَّوَجَلَّ** wills'. Indeed we can only do anything when Allah **عَزَّوَجَلَّ** wills it.

Twenty six Madani pearls for the last 10-day Sunnah I'tikaf

1. During I'tikaf, we will attend the Halqahs (i.e. learning sessions) one hundred per cent, following the schedule completely.
2. We will obey the Halqah Nigran.
3. We will refrain from immoral conduct [i.e. behaviour].
4. During I'tikaf, we will attend all Halqahs along with the Islamic brothers of our respective Halqahs.
5. During rest time, we will go to sleep at the allocated place. We will not sleep anywhere else.
6. During mealtimes, we will eat meals only in our own Halqah.
7. We will not use the mobile phone during the Halqah.
8. During I'tikaf, we will write the Madani pearls obtained from Madani Muzakaraha and from the speeches of the members of Shura and of other preachers.

9. During the revision Halqah, we will do oral test on the Madani pearls obtained from the speeches and from the learning and teaching sessions etc. taking place during the day.
10. If changes are made to Halqahs with the consultation of the Nigran of I'tikaf, so we will obey.
11. Except our own Halqah, we will not insist on sitting in on any other Halqah.
12. If our Halqah Nigran is changed, we will obey the Majlis.
13. We will punctually attend the Halqahs.
14. We will keep the pieces of our luggage such as the blanket, the slippers and the bag etc. at the allocated place, covering them properly and taking care not to make them look messy and untidy.
15. Each Halqah will itself do the dishes [i.e. wash its plates, cups, etc.] and will keep them at a safe place.
16. If any Mu'takif Islamic brother disturbs us, so we will not have an argument with him; instead, we will inform the Nigran of our Halqah about it.
17. In the event of any difficulty, we will solve the problem by contacting our Halqah Nigran. If it is not resolved, we will inform the I'tikaf Nigran.
18. If any Mu'takif becomes ill, we will visit him affectionately.
19. We will do our best to get a prominent position in the constant Qufl-e-Madinah campaign.
20. We will get the honour of offering all five Salahs with congregation and with the first Takbeer in the first row of the Masjid.
21. During I'tikaf, we will try to refrain from useless talking as long as possible.
22. We will continue to practise keeping our eyes lowered while walking.
23. Even when necessary, we will communicate with others by writing.

24. During I'tikaf, we will continue to get the privilege of using the Quf-e-Madinah card and the Quf-e-Madinah glasses.
25. If examinations are administered during the I'tikaf, we will take them.
26. During I'tikaf, we will learn performing our individual acts of worship in a better way.

Last 10-day Sunnah I'tikaf schedule

Dear Islamic brothers! After you have fulfilled your physical needs with good intentions, acting upon Madani In'aam number 1 which is about good intentions, and after you have made Wudu with the intention of remaining in the state of Wudu for the most part of the day, acting upon Madani In'aam number 39, i.e. 'Did you remain in the state of Wudu for most part of the day?', please come to the rows of the Masjid in order to gain the pleasure of Allah **عَزَّوَجَلَّ** and to earn reward. **(إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)** (Appropriate time for these preparations should be announced.) We will have the honour of offering Tahiyya-tul-Wudu and Tahiyya-tul-Masjid, acting upon Madani In'aam number 20, as well as Salat-ut-Tahajjud, acting upon a part of Madani In'aam number 19. **(إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)**

(Then, excellence of offering Salat-ut-Tahajjud, Tahiyya-tul-Wudu and Tahiyya-tul-Masjid should be described. If any Islamic brother starts offering Nafil Salah while excellence is being described, so guide him individually and affectionately.) (Time: 10 minutes)

Excellence of Tahiyya-tul-Wudu

Sayyiduna Abu Hurayrah **رَضِيَ اللَّهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ** has narrated that the Beloved Rasool **صَلَّى اللَّهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ** (once) said to Sayyiduna Bilal **رَضِيَ اللَّهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ**. Tell me the deed you did in the state of Islam which gives you the greatest hope, because I heard your footsteps ahead of me in Paradise. He **رَضِيَ اللَّهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ** humbly replied: I have not performed any such hope-giving deed. However, whenever I perform Wudu anytime during the day or night, I offer as many Rak'aat of Salah as I can. *(Sahih Bukhari, vol. 1, pp. 390, Raqm 1149)*

Ameer-ul-Mu`mineen, Sayyiduna 'Usman-e-Ghani رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ has narrated that he صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ once made Wudu and said: I saw the Holy Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ perform Wudu in the same way. He صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ then said, 'One who performs Wudu as I have done and then offers two Rak'at Salah without making any mistake in them, so his previous sins will be forgiven.'

(Sahih Bukhari, vol. 1, pp. 78, Raqm 159)

Sayyiduna Abu Darda رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ has narrated: I heard the Beloved and Blessed Rasool صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ say, 'One who makes Wudu in an excellent way and then stands up and offers two or four Rak'at performing the Ruku's and Sujood with Khushu and then he seeks forgiveness from Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ, so Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ forgives him.

Excellence of Tahiyya-tul-Masjid

It is narrated by Sayyiduna Abu Qatadah رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ that the Noble Rasool صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ has stated, 'One, who enters the Masjid, should offer two Rak'at (Salah) before sitting.' *(Sahih Bukhari, vol. 1, pp. 170, Hadees 44)*

It is Sunnah for the one who enters the Masjid to offer 2 Rak'at Salah; and to offer 4 Rak'at is better. If someone enters the Masjid at a time when it is Makruh to offer Nafl Salah – for example after the time of Salat-ul-Fajr has started or after Salat-ul-'Asr has been offered – then he should not offer Tahiyya-tul- Masjid. Instead, he should engage in reciting Tasbih (تَسْبِيح), Tahleel (تَهْلِيل) and Salat-'Alan-Nabi, the right of Masjid will be fulfilled.

(Rad-dul-Muhtar, vol. 2, pp. 555)

Reward of offering Tahajjud and Salah at night

Sayyiduna Abu Hurayrah رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ has narrated that the Nabi of Rahmah, the Intercessor of Ummah صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ has said: After Ramadan, the most preferable Siyam are those of Muharram – the month of Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ, and after the obligatory Salah, the most preferable Salah is the one offered at night.

Sayyiduna Abu Hurayrah رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ has narrated that the Nabi of Rahmah, the Intercessor of Ummah صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ has said: When any of you has gone to sleep, so Satan ties three knots at the back part of his head. While tying each knot, he says, 'Sleep long because much part of the night is still left.' When the person wakes up and remembers Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ, so one of the knots is untied. Then, if he makes Wudu, the other knot is untied and if he offers Salah, so the third knot is also untied. And the person is fresh and active in the morning. Otherwise, he feels exhausted in the morning.

Another narration states that he is fresh and active in the morning and gets goodness; otherwise, he feels exhausted in the morning and does not get goodness. It is stated in one more narration: Untie the knots of Satan even if by means of two Rak'aat. *(Sahih Bukhari, vol. 1, pp. 387, Raqm 1142)*

Sayyiduna 'Uqbah Bin 'Aamir رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ has narrated that he heard the Revered and Renowned Rasool صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ say, 'A person from my Ummah wakes up at night and motivates his Nafs to attain purity despite Satan tying knots on him. When the person washes his hands, one knot is untied; when he washes the face, the other knot is untied; when he wipes his head, so the third knot is untied [and] when he washes his feet, so the fourth knot is untied. Then, Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ says to the angels present behind the Hijab, 'See this bondman of Mine. He encourages his Nafs to pray to Me. This bondman will be granted whatever he prays to Me.'

(Al-Ihsan Bittarteeb Sahih Ibn Habbaan, vol. 2, pp. 194, Raqm 119)

Sayyiduna Jabir رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ has narrated that he رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ heard the Holy Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ say, 'At night, there is a certain period of time. If the Muslim bondman asks Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ for anything about the goodness of the world and the Hereafter in that period of time, so Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ certainly grants it to him. And that period of time comes every night.'

Sayyiduna 'Abdullah Bin Salam رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ has stated: When the Holy Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ came to Madinah, flocks of people came to his court. I also came. As I saw his blessed face thoughtfully and enquired about him, I was sure that this is not face of any liar. The very first thing I heard from him was, 'O people! Promote Salam and feed food to the poor and treat your relatives

with kindness and offer Salah at night when people are asleep. You will enter Heaven safely.' (*Sunan-ut-Tirmizi, vol. 4, pp. 219, Raqm 2493*)

Sayyiduna Abu Maalik Ash'ari رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ has narrated that the Greatest and the Noblest Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ has stated: Indeed there are some transparent palaces in Paradise. Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ has prepared those palaces for the people who feed food to the poor, promote Salam and offer Salah at night when people are asleep. (*Sahih Ibn Habbaan, vol. 1, pp. 363, Raqm 509*)

Nawafil

{Recite the Holy Quran at a moderate pace during Nawafil Salah. Neither recite it too fast nor too slow. Recite it in an excellent manner. Recite Surah Al-Ikhlās after Surah Al-Fatihah. (If the Nafl of Tahajjud Salah are offered with congregation, the Salah-leading person must be able to recite the Holy Quran with correct pronunciation following the rules of Quranic recitation. Otherwise, he must not be allowed to lead Salah.) Always remember that we have to keep to the schedule no matter the attendees during any Halqah are in small number or in large number.} (Time: 10 minutes)

Tahiyya-tul-Wudu

(Make the following announcement 20 minutes before the Subh-e-Sadiq.)

'Acting upon a part of Madani In'aam number 20 with the intention of pleasing Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ and earning reward, let's have the privilege of offering the Nawafil of Tahiyya-tul-Wudu.' (إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)

Tahiyya-tul-Masjid

(Now make the following announcement)

'Acting upon a part of Madani In'aam number 20 with the intention of pleasing Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ and earning reward, let's have the privilege of offering the Nawafil of Tahiyya-tul-Masjid.' (إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)

Tahajjud

(Now make the following announcement)

‘Acting upon a part of Madani In’aam number 19 with the intention of pleasing Allah **عَزَّوَجَلَّ** and earning reward, let’s have the privilege of offering the Nawafil of Tahajjud.’ (إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ **عَزَّوَجَلَّ**)

Madani pearls of Du’a

After the Munajat (Du’a), at least one hour should be left for Sahari. Any good Na’at Khuwan should recite the Munajat that should end within ten minutes. Munajat should only be recited from the book ‘Wasail-e-Bakhshish’ published by Maktaba-tul-Madinah.

(Now make the following announcement)

‘Acting upon Madani In’aam number 44 with the intention of pleasing Allah **عَزَّوَجَلَّ** and earning reward, let’s have the privilege of making Du’a with concentration and humility.’ (إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ **عَزَّوَجَلَّ**)

(Now tell the manners of raising hands during Du’a)

Dear Islamic brothers! Du’a is the essence of worship. The Qiblah for Du’a is the sky. Therefore, keep your palms towards the sky during Du’a. Raise your palms such that they are in the straightness of your chest or shoulders or they are so high that the whiteness of the armpits appear [i.e. raise hands fully]. Raise your hands according to the method described. Lower your heads in shame. Remember your sins and pray to Allah **عَزَّوَجَلَّ** tearfully.

Munajat

Other Munajats may also be recited in addition to the following one:

(Now start Du'a in these words)

Feeling sure that your prayer is going to be answered, humbly say
 يَا رَحْمَنُ، يَا رَحِيمُ in the court of your Merciful Creator:

It is a great favour of Yours that You have made me a human being, a Muslim and a follower of Your Beloved Rasool صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ. O Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ! O the Creator of Muhammad صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ! How can I express my thanks to You for granting me the privilege of performing I'tikaf!

O Lord of Mustafa! You know how weak and helpless I am. Alas! I am so weak that neither can I bear heat nor cold. I cannot bear being bitten by a bug or a mosquito or even by an ant. Alas! If a winged insect crawls on my body, it makes me jump with fear. Alas! I am going to be doomed. If I suffer Your wrath in my grave due to my sins, what will I do? Alas! If snakes and scorpions cling to my body under my shroud, what will become of me?

O Lord of Muhammad! Bestow grace upon me for the sake of Muhammad صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ. Protect me from the pains of death and from the troubles of the grave and of the Judgement Day. Indeed, if You bestow grace upon me, then this life and the afterlife of mine will both be better. O the Lord of the Beloved Nabi! Have mercy on me and get pleased with me forever and make me a bondman You like. O the Creator of my Beloved Nabi! No matter I have filled the earth and the sky with my sins but still I am hopeful of Your mercy. O Almighty! For the sake of my Ghaus-e-A'zam رَحْمَةُ اللهِ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ, my Ghareeb Nawaz رَحْمَةُ اللهِ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ, my Imam Ahmad Raza Khan رَحْمَةُ اللهِ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ and my kind Murshid, forgive me without accountability, forgive me without accountability, forgive me without accountability. Aameen!

Sahari break

(Now make the following announcement)

Acting upon Madani In'aam number 36 with the intention of pleasing Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ and earning reward, we will keep with our eyes lowered while going to make Wudu for eating food, (إِنْ شَاءَ اللهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ). Acting upon Madani In'aam number 1, we will make good intentions, (إِنْ شَاءَ اللهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ). Acting upon Madani In'aam number 11, we will get the honour of eating food less than

our appetite in a clay pot while sitting and observing 'Parday mayn Pardah, i.e. veil within veil'. After eating food (Sahari), we will make preparations for Salat-ul-Fajr. Acting upon Madani In'aam number 4, we will reply to the Azan and the Iqamah. Acting upon Madani In'aam number 18, we will offer Sunnat-e-Qabliyyah and, acting upon Madani In'aam number 2, we will offer Salat-ul-Fajr with congregation and with the first Takbeer in the first row.

(إِنَّ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)

(Encourage the Islamic brothers to wash hands properly with any soap while making the Wudu for eating food. Make them have good intentions before eating and encourage them to do it every time they eat food. Make them recite Du'a for eating. Tell them how to break the bread and what the size of the morsel should be. Explain to them the wisdom of wrapping a rubber band around the ring finger and the little one. Motivate them to eat with three fingers, while sitting according to Sunnah. During this, an Islamic brother should also recite appropriate couplets of Na'at or Munajat etc. to the attendees. After you have wiped the pot clean, show it to others with the intention of motivating them to wipe it clean. Also encourage them to pour a little water into the wiped clean pots and cups etc. and drink it. Also persuade them to pick up and eat the bits of food fallen on the dining-mat. During every mealtime, the Nigran Islamic brother should be present in any Halqah, especially the weak one, where he should sit and overcome weaknesses with a smiling face. Make them recite Du'as after eating. At the end, recite Surah Al-Ikhlās and Surah Quraysh.)

Salat-ul-Fajr

(Tasbih-e-Fatimah)

(The Imam will lead the Du'a after the Salah. Make the following announcement after the Du'a.)

Acting upon Madani In'aam number 3 with the intention of pleasing Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ and earning reward, let's recite Ayat-ul-Kursi, Tasbih-e-Fatimah and Surah Al-Ikhlās one time each. (Time: 3 minutes)

Recitation of Quran

(Now make the following announcement)

(Time: 20 minutes)

Acting upon Madani In'aam number 70 with the intention of pleasing Allah **عَزَّوَجَلَّ** and earning reward, let's get the honour of reciting the Holy Quran, **(إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)**.

Now the Islamic brothers of the first and the third rows should turn and face the Islamic brothers of the second and the fourth rows respectively. Take care that you should recite the Holy Quran with audible voice to your own ears. The Islamic brothers who want to revise the lesson of the Madani Qa'idah may do so during this period.

(Then the well-wishing Islamic brothers should immediately start distributing the copies of the Holy Quran. Remember to appoint an appropriate number of Islamic brothers to distribute the copies of the Holy Quran. If the Mu'takifeen are in large number, so appoint more well-wishing Islamic brothers so that all Islamic brothers get the copy of the Holy Quran without delay.)

Awraad from Shajarah

(Now make the following announcement)

(Time: 10 minutes)

'Acting upon a part of Madani In'aam number 5 with the intention of pleasing Allah **عَزَّوَجَلَّ** and earning reward, let's have the privilege of reciting at least a few Awraad from the Shajarah, **(إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)**.'

(Now make them recite the following Awraad)

1. 'If one recites **أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ السَّمِيعِ الْعَلِيمِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ** three times and then recites the last 3 Ayahs of Surah Al-Hashr once in the morning, 70 thousand angels will seek forgiveness for him till the evening. If he dies on that day, he will be a martyr. If one recites the same in the evening, there is the same reward for him till the morning.'

Dear Islamic brothers! Let me recite it. You just listen to it attentively.

2. By virtue of reciting the following Wird in the morning and evening three times each, the reciter will die with Iman (faith). You also recite it.

3. By virtue of reciting the following Wird in the morning and evening three times each, the reciter will gain protection of his religion, faith, life, wealth and family. You also recite it.

- After Salat-ul-Fajr, whoever remains seated on his place [i.e. the place where he offered Salah], until he offers the Salah of Ishraq, and speaks only what is good, his sins are forgiven even if they are more than the foam of the ocean. *(Sunan Abi Dawood, pp. 41, vol. 2, Hadees 1287)*
- It is narrated by Sayyiduna Abu Hurayrah **رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ** that the Nabi of Rahmah **صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ** has stated, 'Whoever regularly performs 2 Rak'aat of Chasht Salah, his sins are forgiven even if they are equal to the foam of the ocean.' *(Sunan Ibn Majah, pp. 153, 154, vol. 2, Hadees 1382)*
- Sayyiduna Abu Hurayrah **رَضِيَ اللهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهُ** narrated that the Greatest and Noblest Nabi **صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ** has stated: Indeed there is a door in

9. **Lesson 7:** Identifying the letters of Maddah. Make them properly understand how to prolong the sound.
10. **Lesson 8 and 9:** Focus on lesson number 8 to explain how to prolong the sound equivalent to an Alif, and focus on lesson number 9 to explain how to read letters/words without prolonging the sound.

Madinah: Those Islamic brothers who have completed the Madani Qa'idah early or who have already studied it should be made to revise the last ten Surahs.

Preparations for Salat-ul-'Asr

Acting upon Madani In'aam number 36 with the intention of pleasing Allah ﷻ and earning reward, we will keep our eyes lowered while going to make Wudu and, acting upon Madani In'aam number 1, we will make good intentions for making Wudu. Acting upon Madani In'aam number 4, we will reply to the Azan and the Iqamah. Acting upon Madani In'aam number 18, we will offer Sunnat-e-Qabliyyah and, acting upon Madani In'aam number 2, we will offer Salat-ul-Asr with congregation and with the first Takbeer in the first row. (اِنَّ شَاءَ اللّٰهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)

Tasbih-e-Fatimah

(The Imam will lead the Du'a after the Salah. Make the following announcement after the Du'a.)

Madinah: Every Thursday, the schedule of the weekly Sunnah-inspiring Ijtima' will be followed.

Acting upon Madani In'aam number 3 with the intention of pleasing Allah ﷻ and earning reward, let's recite Ayat-ul-Kursi, Tasbih-e-Fatimah and Surah Al-Ikhlās one time each. (Time: 3 minutes)

Madani Muzakarah

As soon as the Madani Muzakarah starts, stop the activities of the schedule. Now all Islamic brothers have to attend the Madani Muzakarah. Being a well-wisher of his Islamic brothers, the Nigran of the Halqah should himself make all the Islamic brothers attend the Madani Muzakarah by motivating them personally.

Until 20 Ramadan, video Madani Muzakarah should be watched. During the last ten days, only audio Madani Muzakarah should be listened to. (Watch the Madani Muzakarah at a place that is neither Masjid nor Fina-e-Masjid. Do not also watch it at the place where people get the impression that Madani Channel is being watched in Masjid.)

If it is not possible to watch or listen to the Madani Muzakarah due to some valid reason, then deliver speeches as per the following schedule.

Speech

(Time: 41 minutes)

(Madinah: These are the speeches prepared by 'Al-Madina-tul-Ilmiyyah' to be delivered during the weekly Sunnah-inspiring Ijtima'.)

1. Manners of Masjid
2. Importance of Niyat (intention)
3. Quf-e-Madinah of the tongue
4. Quf-e-Madinah of the eyes
5. Warnings of punishment for missing the congregational Salah
6. Blessings of Madani In'amaat
7. Destructiveness of telling lies
8. Booklet: Sada-e-Madinah
9. Aim of life
10. Blessings of call to righteousness

At the end of every speech, explain any one of the 12 Madani activities, motivating the Mu'takifeen to participate in them. The booklets of some of

the Madani activities such as 12 Madani Activities, Sada-e-Madinah, Chowk Dars have been published. You may also take help from them.

Awraad from Shajarah

(Now make the following announcement)

‘Acting upon a part of Madani In’aam number 5 with the intention of pleasing Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ and earning reward, let’s have the privilege of reciting at least a few Awraad from the Shajarah.’ (إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)

(Now make them recite the following Awraad)

1. ‘If one recites عَزَّوَجَلَّ بِاللهِ السَّمِيعِ الْعَلِيمِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ three times and then recites the last 3 Ayahs of Surah Al-Hashr once in the morning, 70 thousand angels will seek forgiveness for him till the evening. If he dies on that day, he will be a martyr. If one recites the same in the evening, there is the same reward for him till the morning.’

Dear Islamic brothers! Let me recite it. You just listen to it attentively.

2. By virtue of reciting the following Wird in the morning and evening three times each, the reciter will die with Iman (faith). You also recite it.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّا نَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ أَنْ نُشْرِكَ بِكَ شَيْئًا نَعْلَمُهُ وَنَسْتَغْفِرُكَ لِمَا لَا نَعْلَمُهُ ط

3. By virtue of reciting the following Wird in the morning and evening three times each, the reciter will gain protection of his religion, faith, life, wealth and family. You also recite it.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ عَلَى دِينِي بِسْمِ اللَّهِ عَلَى نَفْسِي وَوُلْدِي وَاهْلِي وَمَالِي

4. Reciting the following Wird in the morning and evening three times each is a means of protection from snakes, scorpions and other dangerous animals. You also recite it.

أَعُوذُ بِكَلِمَاتِ اللَّهِ التَّامَّاتِ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا خَلَقَ

Du'a-e-Iftar

(During Du'a-e-Iftar, any Islamic brother with a good voice should recite praying couplets from the book 'Wasail-e-Bakhshish' published by Maktaba-tul-Madinah.)

Salat-ul-Maghrib

(Tasbih-e-Fatimah)

(The Imam will lead the second Du'a after the Salah. Make the following announcement after the Du'a.)

Acting upon Madani In'aam number 3 with the intention of pleasing Allah عَزَّوَجَلَّ and earning reward, let's recite Ayat-ul-Kursi, Tasbih-e-Fatimah and Surah Ikhlas one time each. (Time: 3 minutes)

Surah Al-Mulk

(Surah Al-Mulk should only be recited by the Islamic brother who can recite it following the rules of Quranic recitation and with correct pronunciation.)

(Now make the following announcement)

Acting upon a part of the Madani In'aam number 3 with the intention of pleasing Allah **عَزَّوَجَلَّ** and earning reward, let's have the honour of reciting and listening to Surah Al-Mulk. **(إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)**

Dinner break and preparation for Salat-ul-'Isha and Taraweeh

(Now make the following announcement)

Acting upon Madani In'aam number 36 with the intention of pleasing Allah **عَزَّوَجَلَّ** and earning reward, we will keep our eyes lowered while going to make Wudu for eating food. **(إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)**. Acting upon Madani In'aam number 1, we will make good intentions, **(إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)**. Acting upon Madani In'aam number 11, we will eat food less than our appetite in a clay pot while sitting and observing 'Parday mayn Pardah, i.e. veil within veil'.

After eating food, we will make preparations for Salat-ul-'Isha and Taraweeh. Acting upon Madani In'aam number 4, we will reply to the Azan and the Iqamah. Acting upon Madani In'aam number 18, we will offer Sunnat-e-Qabliyyah and, acting upon Madani In'aam number 2, we will offer Salat-ul-'Isha with congregation and with the first Takbeer in the first row. Receiving the blessings of the month of Ramadan, we will offer Taraweeh Salah with congregation. Acting upon Madani In'aam number 18, we will also get the privilege of offering Nafil Salah that is offered at the end of the Isha Salah. **(إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ عَزَّوَجَلَّ)**

(Encourage the Islamic brothers to wash hands properly with any soap while making the Wudu for eating food. Make them have good intentions before eating and encourage them to do it every time they eat food. Make them recite Du'a for eating. Tell them how to break the bread and what the size of the morsel should be. Explain to them the wisdom of wrapping a rubber band around the ring finger and the little one. Motivate them to eat with three

fingers, while sitting according to Sunnah. During this, an Islamic brother should also recite appropriate couplets of Na'at or Munajat etc. to the attendees. After you have wiped the pot clean, show it to others with the intention of motivating them to wipe it clean.

Also encourage them to pour a little water into the wiped clean pots and cups etc. and drink it. Also persuade them to pick up and eat the bits of food fallen on the dining-mat. During every mealtime, the Nigran Islamic brother should be present in any Halqah, especially the weak one, where he should sit and overcome weaknesses with a smiling face. Make them recite Du'as after eating. At the end, recite Surah Ikhlas and Surah Quraysh.)

Salat-ul-'Isha and Taraweeh

(Tasbih-e-Fatimah)

(The Imam will lead the second Du'a after the Salah. Make the following announcement after the Du'a.)

Acting upon Madani In'aam number 3 with the intention of pleasing Allah ﷻ and earning reward, let's recite Ayat-ul-Kursi, Tasbih-e-Fatimah and Surah Ikhlas one time each. (Time: 3 minutes)

Madani Muzakarah

As soon as the Madani Muzakarah starts, stop the activities of the schedule. Now all Islamic brothers have to attend the Madani Muzakarah. Being a well-wisher of his Islamic brothers, the Nigran of the Halqah should himself make all the Islamic brothers attend the Madani Muzakarah by motivating them personally.
