Will The Blessed Awliya Also Make Shafa'at [Intercession]?

Question

What do the blessed 'Ulama [Islamic scholars] and Muftis [Islamic jurists] state regarding the following matter: Will the Awliya of Allah also intercede on the Day of Judgement? I have heard that only the Beloved Rasool مَثَى الله عَلَيْهِ وَ اللهِ وَسَلَّم will intercede.(Questioner: Owais Raza, Madina-tul-Awliya, Multan)

بِسُمِ اللهِ الرَّحْلُنِ الرَّحِيْمِ

ٱلْجَوَابُ بِعَوْنِ الْمَلِكِ الْوَهَّابِ اللَّهُمَّ هِدَايَةَ الْحَقِّ وَالصَّوَابِ

On the Day of Judgement, blessed Awliya رَحِمَهُمُ اللهُ , 'Ulama, Huffaz and Hujjaj will all intercede. In fact, every individual who has been blessed with a religious position and status will intercede for his family members and relatives. At this place, A'la Hadrat, Imam Ahmad Raza Khan مَثَنُ الله عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم will make Shafa'at [intercession] in the court of Allah عَزُّ وَجَلُّ الله عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم will make Shafa'at [intercession] in the court of Allah الله عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم and all other intercessors will intercede for their family members and relatives in the court of the Beloved Rasool عَلَّ الله عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم is also Shafa'at [intercession]; it is not something else.

It is stated in Al-Mu'taqad-ul-Muntaqad [المعتقدالمنتقد]:

والشهداء والصلحين وكثيرمن المومنين وغيرهم من القرآن والصيام والكعبة وغيرها مماوردفي السنة

And it is Wajib [compulsory] to have Iman [faith] in the fact that besides the Beloved Rasool مَتَّ الله عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم, other Ambiya, angels, 'Ulama, Shuhada [martyrs], pious people and a large number of Mu'mineen, and besides them, the Holy Quran, Sawm [fast], Ka'bah, etc., all those regarding whose intercession, the information has been given in Ahadees will also intercede.(Al-Mu'taqad-ul-Muntaqad,pp.129)

Mentioning the condition of the Day of Judgement, Sadr-ush-Shari'ah, Mufti Amjad Ali A'zami كَنْ أَنْ الْمُعَلَيْكُ has stated: Then (i.e. when the door of Shafa'at will open) all the Ambiya will make intercession for their Ummah, and the blessed Awliya, Shuhada, 'Ulama, Huffaz, Hujjaj, in fact every individual who has been blessed with a religious position and status will make intercession for the people associated with him. Na-Baaligh [A child who has not yet reached puberty]children who have died will intercede for their parents. Moreover, some such people will also come to 'Ulama who will humbly say, 'We had filled water for you to make Wudu at such and such a time' 'Ulama will make intercession even for them.(Bahar-e-Shari'at,vol.1,pp.139-141summarized)

Except for the Beloved Rasool صَلَّى الله عَلَيْهِ وَ اللهِ وَسَلَّم بِهُ الطَّلُوةُ وَالسَّلَام , the entire Creation, even the blessed Ambiya صَلَّى will present their intercession in the court of the Beloved Rasool صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِمُ الصَّلُوةُ وَالسَّلَام , as the authority of their intercessions is the Beloved Rasool الله عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم The Beloved Rasool . وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم

'اذاكانيوم القيمة كنت امام النبيين وخطيبهم وصاحب شفاعتهم غير فخر' Translation: When it will be the Day of Judgement, I will be the Imam and Khateeb of Ambiya and I am the authority of their intercession. I am not saying it as pride. (Sunan-ut-Tirmizi,vol.5,pp.353,Hadees3633)

Mentioning the beautiful meaning of this blessed Hadees, A'la Hadrat, Imam Ahmad Raza Khan رَحْبَةُ اللهُ عَلَيْه has stated:

والمعنى الآخرالالطف الاشرف ان لاشفاعة لاحدبلاواسطة عندذى العرش جل جلاله الاللقر آن العظيم ولهذا الحبيب المرتجى الكريم صلى الله تعالى عليه وسلم، واماسائر الشفعاء من الملائكة والانبياء والاولياء والعلماء والحفاظ والشهداء والحجاج والصلحاء، فعند رسول الله تعليه وسلم الله تعليه وسلم يشفع لمن ذكروه ولمن لم يذكروا عندر به عزوجل وقد تاكد عندناهذا المعنى باحاديث ولله الحمد

Translation: The second meaning of this blessed Hadees which is very beautiful and blessedis that only the Holy Quran and the Beloved Rasool مَنَّ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم have the right of direct Shafa'at in the Divine court, and we have hopes from him; none except them has this right. The rest of the intercessors, i.e. the intercession of angels, Ambiya, Awliya, 'Ulama, Huffaz, Shuhada, Hujjaj, and Saliheen [pious people] will be in the court of the Beloved Rasool مَنَّ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم and bring intercession; and in the court of Allah عَزَّ وَجَلَّ به the Beloved Rasool مَنَّ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم will make intercession for those mentioned, and besides them, for those who are not mentioned. According to our opinion, this meaning is strongly supported by many Ahadees, وَاللهُ وَاللهُ وَاللهُ الْمُعَلِيْهِ وَاللهُ وَاللهُ الْمُعَلِيْهِ وَاللهُ وَاللهُ الْمُعَلِيْهِ وَاللهُ وَاللهُ الْمُعَلِيْهِ وَاللهُ وَاللهُ

In Fatawa Razawiyyah, A'la Hadrat رَحْبَةُ الله عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم has stated: It is proved from Ahadees that the Beloved Rasool صَلَّى الله عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم is the authority of intercession. He مَزَّ وَجَلَّ will be the Shafi' [شَفِيع] [intercessor] in the court of Allah عَزَّ وَجَلَّ , and 'Ulama and Awliya will make intercession of those associated with them in the court of the Beloved Rasool صَلَّى الله وَسَلَّم (FatawaRazawiyyah,vol.21,pp.464)

Sadr-ush-Shari'ah, Mufti Amjad Ali A'zami رَضَةُ الله عَلَيْهِ وَالله وَسَلَّم has stated: On the Day of Judgement, the status of Shafa'at-e-Kubra [the greatest intercession] is amongst the peculiarities of the Beloved Rasool (صَلَّى الله عَلَيْهِ وَالله وَسَلَّم); no one will have the courage to make intercession unless the Beloved Rasool (صَلَّى الله عَلَيْهِ وَالله وَسَلَّم) opens the "Door of Intercession". In fact, actually all the intercessors will bring intercession in the court of the Beloved Rasool (صَلَّى الله عَلَيْهِ وَ الله وَسَلَّم), and amongst Creation, only the Beloved Rasool (صَلَّى الله عَلَيْهِ وَ الله وَسَلَّم) is the Shafi' [intercessor] in the court of Allah عَزَّ وَجَلَّ (Bahar-e-Shari'at,vol.1,pp.70)
