Can a woman recite Surah Kausar during her menses?

What do the scholars of Islam say about the following matter: Can a woman recite Surah Al-Kausar during her menses with the intention of praise?

It is not allowed for a woman to recite Surah Al-Kausar during her menstrual cycle, and it is a sin. This is because the wording of this Surah is in the first person (Mutakallim), which shows that the words of this Surah are specific to the Quran, and it is not allowed for a woman to recite the Quran while menstruating.

Regarding a 'Junbi' (person in the state of extreme impurity) and menstruating woman reciting Quran, it is stated in *Jami' Al-Tirmizi*:

Translation: It is narrated from The Blessed Prophet صلى الله عليه وآله وسلم that he has stated: "A menstruating woman and a Junbi should not recite anything from the Quran." (Jami'al-Tirmizi, Vol.1, p.236, Egypt)

It says in *al-Jawharah al-Nayyirah*:

(Al-Jawharahal-Nayyirah, Vol1, Pg30, Publ. Matb'ahal-Khayriyyah)

It says in Fatawa Razawiyyah:

Translation: Due to the pronoun "اناأعطينا" from Surah Kausar being in the first person, it is specific to Quran. (FatawaRazawiyyah, Vol. 1, Pt. 2, p. 1,114, Publ. Raza Foundation, Lahore)

It says in Fawaid al-Razawiyyah:

جنب کووہ آیاتِ ثنابہ نیتِ ثنا بھی پڑھناحرام ہے، جن میں ربعزوجل نے اپنے لئے متکلم کی ضمیریں ذکر فرمائیں۔

Translation: It is Haram for a Junub to read the verses which include Sana, though with the intention of Sana (praise), in which Allah Almighty has used first person pronouns for himself." (Fawaidal-Razawiyyah, Vol. 1, Pt. 2, p. 1, 114, Publ. Raza Foundation, Lahore)

وَاللَّهُ أَعْلَمُ عَزَّوجَلَّ وَرَسُولُه أَعْلَم صَلَّى اللهُ تَعَالَى عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم

(Allah Almighty knows best and His Messenger صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَ اللهِ وَسَلَّم knows best.)
