## Is it Permissible to Apply Deodorant to the Body Before the Intention of Iḥrām?

## Question

What do the scholars of Islam say regarding the following matter: can one apply deodorant to the body before making the intention of Iḥrām (the sacred state for Hajj or 'Umrah) to avoid body odour?

## Answer



Applying perfume or fragrance to the body before making the intention of Iḥrām is a Sunnah and is proven from the blessed practice of the beloved Prophet صَلَّى السُّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ. Therefore, in the above scenario, if a person applies deodorant to the body before making the intention of Iḥrām to avoid odour, it is permissible and correct; in fact, it is ideal.
