



Ruling Regarding Renting A House From A Qadiani?

What do the respected scholars say about the matter of renting a house from a Qadiani?

بسم الله الرحين الرحيم الله المحقو الصواب اللهم هداية الحق و الصواب

Qadianis are disbelievers and Murtad (apostates) because of believing in Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Kazzab (the liar) as a prophet and because of several other blasphemous beliefs. And the ruling of Shari'ah regarding apostates is that associating with them, sitting with them, eating, drinking and engaging in transactions with, etc., are all Haram and extremely sinful actions. Therefore, renting a house from a Qadiani is not permissible.

A Hadith in Sahih Muslim states:

Translation: Beware of them and stay away from them, lest they mislead you or put you into tribulation.

(Sahih Muslim, Volume 1, Page 12, Beirut Edition)

Under this Hadith, Mufti Ahmad Yar Khan Naeemi (رحبةاللهعليه) writes:

''اس سے معلوم ہوا کہ بدمذ ہبوں سے بچناضر وری ہے کیو نکہ ان کی صحبت دین وایمان کے لیئے خطرہ ہے''۔

Translation: This proves that it is necessary to avoid

people of corrupt beliefs, for their company is dangerous for one's religion and faith.

(Miraat-tul-Manajih, Volume 1, Page 158, Naeemi Kitab Khana, Gujarat)

Regarding entering into a hiring contract with an apostate, Imam Ahle-e-Sunnat Ash-Sha, Imam Ahmad Raza Khan (عليه رحبة الرحبن) states:

''نه ان کی نوکری کرنے کی اجازت، نه انہیں نو کرر کھنے کی اجازت که ان سے دور بھا گئے اور انہیں اپنے سے دور کرنے ک کرنے کا حکم ہے۔رسول اللہ صلی اللہ علیہ وسلم فرماتے ہیں''ایا کہ وایا ہم لایضلونکم ولایفتنونکم'' لینی: ان سے بچو، انہیں دورر کھو کہ کہیں وہ شمصیں گر اہنہ کر دیں تمہیں فتنے میں نہ ڈال دیں۔

Translation: Both working under them and employing them are impermissible actions for the order is to flee from them and to keep them away from oneself. The Messenger of Allah said, 'Beware of them and stay away from them, lest they mislead you or put you into tribulation.

At another place regarding dealings with apostates, Sayyidi Aala Hazrat Imam Ahmad Raza Khan (عليه رحبة الرحبن) says:

Translation: Qadianis are Murtad (apostates). Nothing should be sold to and bought from them. Even to talk to them is not permissible.

(Fatawa Razviyyah, Volume 23, Page 598, Raza Foundation, Lahore)

It is stated in Waqaar-ul-Fatawa:

'' قادیانیوں کے دونوں گروپ (لاہوری اور احمدی) کافرومر تدہیں اور مرتد کے احکام اہلِ کتاب اور مشر کین سے جداہیں، نثریعت کے مطابق مسلمان ، مرتد سے معاملات بھی نہیں کر سکتا،اس سے ملناجُلنا کھانا پیناسب ناجائز ہے۔۔۔لہذاان سے تجارت رکھنا، اٹھنا، بیٹھنا کھاناپیناسب حرام ہے۔"

Translation: Both groups of Qadianis (Lahori and Ahmadi) are disbelievers and Murtad (apostates), and the rulings for apostates differ from those for People of the Book and polytheists. According to Shariah, a Muslim cannot even engage in dealings with an apostate. Associating with them, eating and drinking with them, all these are the impermissible actions...... Therefore, engaging in business with them, sitting with them, eating and drinking with them - all of it is haram.
